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




### Monitoring, Benchmarking and Forecasting

  - Shared definitions and classifications of innovation leadership skills (e-CF and IT professional profiles)
  - Scoreboard and index for benchmarking and ranking
  - New approaches for quantification, demand, supply measurement and forecasting (use of online vacancy data & sources like LinkedIn)
  - World-class best practices
    repository: learning practices
  - European observatory mechanism: one-stop-shop gateway



# Industry, education and training

- Higher Education needs to change ...
  - ... lifelong learning institutions, new partnerships and players
  - Workforce credentialling: new certification
  - Embedding technical multidisciplinarity in the curriculum & non-technical courses in technical curricula
  - Updating the skills of teachers/professors
  - Reverse monitoring



# **Online Career Support and Recruitment**

  - Toolbox supporting

  - National Advisory Boards for informed policy development




# Promotion and Awareness Raising
